Addressing Hepatitis, HIV, STIs and TB

EuroTEST is a pan-European initiative launched in 2007. It aims to ensure that people living with HIV, viral hepatitis, sexually transmitted infections and tuberculosis are diagnosed early and linked to care.

Experts from civil society, health care, policy institutions and public health institutions collaborate to build the evidence base to support earlier diagnosis and care and to influence both guidelines, practices and policies at European level.

The initiative provides a platform for information exchange, research and activities across Europe. This includes projects, such as European Testing Week and European Test Finder.
